

HOW TO HELP A LOST OR FOUND PET

For Lost pets:

Post on and check all "Found" posts daily on:

If microchipped, contact the microchip company and report your pet as LOST.

For Found pets:

Please take to any vet clinic to scan for a microchip. If chipped, contact the microchip company with the ID# and they will contact the registered owner.

Check all "Lost" posts on all sites above

If not microchipped, please ask possible owners for proof of ownership - photos with dog, vet records, unusual characteristics/markings.

If convenient and possible, return pet at their vet office for further verification of ownership or at a police substation or other public area.

(If chipped, but microchip data is not registered or updated, ask for help on the lost/found sites - there is usually someone who is able to track down "dead-end" chips!)

Please do not rehome found pets immediately as there may be a heartbroken family desperately looking for this pet!
